We work very hard to provide a loving and safe environment for our children. Our nurseries are staffed by paid workers to provide the best quality care. Trained staff provide a safe nursery as well as consistency for the children and their parents.

This brochure is provided to help you become familiar with our nursery and its policies and procedures. Please read this and feel free to contact us with any questions or concerns regarding our nursery. Thank you for the trust you are placing in us; we will do our best to be faithful in all that we do.

Childcare Policy

The purpose of our church nursery/ childcare facility is to provide a safe and loving environment for children. We are here to support parents and guardians for service and ministry in the church and to enable them to hear and study the word of God during worship services and small group settings. Parents MUST remain on campus.

When is Nursery Provided?

The church will provide nursery care for those participating in onsite events such as:

- Church-wide services and Sunday school classes
- Church-wide events where there is teaching and ministry (choir rehearsals, special programs, fellowship dinners, etc.)

What to Bring to the Nursery?

Church provides:

- A loving, nurturing Christian environment with a trained staff
- A clean, safe environment

Parent provides:

- 2-3 Diapers and wipes
- Labeled bottles, pacifiers, sippy cups and diaper bag
- Well children

Nursery Enrollment, Receiving, and Dismissal:

1. On the child's first visit to the nursery, the parent should complete an enrollment card and information sheet.
2. When you bring your child to the nursery, you will need to sign your child in. You will also need to complete a two-part name tag. Place the first part on your child's back and keep the second part with you. Bring the second part back with you in order to turn it in and pick-up your child.
3. Please leave a phone number in the event we need to reach you.
4. For smooth transitions, we request that only one parent come into the room to drop off/pick up child.
5. Facilities are open 15 minutes prior to all scheduled activities. Please NEVER leave a child in a nursery room without a nursery staff member present.
6. Please return to the nursery immediately following the end of scheduled church activities.
7. Please be aware that you will be notified immediately if an emergency should arise.
8. We recommend that you do not come to the nursery to visit your child until you are ready to leave.

9. Please be sure that all items belonging to your child are clearly labeled.
10. Please be sure to provide nursery workers with any new or pertinent information regarding your child so your child can receive the best care possible.



Illness and Medication Policy:

1. Please do not bring a child to the nursery who appears ill or who has had a fever within the past 24 hours. Some signs of illness include: unusual fatigue, irritability, coughing, sneezing, runny nose and eyes, colored nasal discharge, fever, vomiting or diarrhea, inflamed mouth/throat, suspicious skin rash.
2. Parents of children who appear ill during their stay in the nursery will be notified. The nursery staff has authority to turn away sick children from staying in the nursery.
3. If your child does contract an illness following a session in the nursery, please inform the nursery supervisor.
