

Summer Youth Intern

Overview: The intern of the Youth Ministry at FUMC Winter Park will help encourage students to begin a relationship with Jesus Christ that lasts a lifetime. This intern will help provide leadership for a ministry that is in a season of growth and strength. This internship will help train the right individual in the various aspects of youth ministry, including “behind-the-scenes” and connectional youth ministry.

Description and Responsibilities:

- Connect with students as assigned by the Youth Staff.
- Help in organizing and maintaining organization of all youth materials.
- Assist Youth Staff with promoting upcoming events via social media.
- Attend trips and retreats as needed in order to assist the Youth Ministry Staff.
- Plan, lead and execute all Sunday Night programming for the summer.
- Support an environment of mutual respect and support is upheld through biblical conflict management and honest communication.
- Maintain a regular work schedule, including Sabbath time. As this is a part time position, hours must be maintained and communicated to the Director and Assistant Director.

Time Commitment: 20 hours per week (time off will be used to supplement time on overnight trips) at \$10 an hour for 10 weeks. Housing with a church family will be available for the right candidate.

Special Talents, Skills Preferred: a passion for youth ministry and willingness to grow and learn. Prior experience will be preferred.

Resources and Training Provided: Weekly training and encouragement sessions with ministry leadership.

Reporting structure: This position will meet weekly with the whole youth staff and one on one with the Assistant Director for instruction and encouragement.
